- * We strengthened the language in the collective bargaining agreements to ensure that moving forward DC16 workforce will have the training and certifications needed to support your businesses.


MARKET GROWTH

GIVING BACK



QP1/QP2 AND CAS CERTIFICATION GRANTS

To support our contractor members who strive to achieve a QP1 or QP2 accreditations and their workforce seeking CAS certifications, NCPFC continues to provide a grant to cover the full cost of a new QP accreditation fee or 50% of the cost of a QP renewal fee and reimbursement for the testing time for up to 10 painters to get CAS 1 or CAS 2 certified. Grants will continue in 2024

2023 PAINTERS CBA NEGOTIATIONS RECAP

After a fourth vote, the 2023-2026 DC16 NCPFC Painters Master Agreement was ratified by the DC16 union membership on July 14, 2023 after an eight-day strike.

The changes made were:

A 3-year Agreement with annual raises of \$3.50, \$3.25, and \$3.25 for Commercial Painters.

Industrial painters receive the same increase as the Commercial painters, in addition to a \$2.25,

\$2.50 and \$2.75 premium each year over the 3-year Agreement.

Bridge painters receive the same increase as the Commercial painters, in addition to a \$4.25, \$4.50 and \$4.75 premium each year over the 3-year Agreement.

Specified journeyperson training and certifications are required to be completed and maintained before union employees can be dispatched.

Shift pay increased from 15% to 20% and parking allowance increased to \$35 per day.

Defined shop requirement language that allows for multiple points of dispatch options from your company's shop locations.



2024 GLAZIERS CBA NEGOTIATIONS PREP

The 2021-2024 Northern California Glaziers Master Agreement will expire on June 30, 2024. Staff and the NCGMA Negotiations Committee have been busy preparing for the upcoming negotiations with District Council 16. Active Members of NCGMA are able to provide feedback on what they would like to see changed, added or removed from the current Agreement prior to the start of negotiations this year. We also plan to host zoom and in-person meetings to get contractor feedback from companies of all sizes.





NACC AND AGMT CERTIFICATION GRANTS

To support our contractor members who strive to achieve a NACC certifications and their workforce seeking AGMT certifications, NCGMA continued to provide a grant in 2024 to cover the full annual cost of the NACC accreditation fee and reimbursement for the testing time for up to 10 glaziers to get certified. Grants will continue in 2024.
